INTRODUCTION TO MUSIC PROGRAM ages 6-8 (guitar, piano, voice)

Our Camp is pleased to offer a special program for young students ages 6-8, who have had no formal training or up to one year of study in **Guitar**, **Piano**, or **Voice**/ **Musical Theater**. Your child will be taught by our expert teachers and enjoy ageappropriate classes with their peers. After experiencing our fun program, we hope to inspire your child to want to continue studying music! In a safe, nurturing environment, guided by teachers and counselors, campers will be instructed in the basics of the instrument of their choice – guitar, piano, or voice. And everyone gets to perform with their class in our final concert!

MUSICAL THEATER PROGRAM

Elementary – ages 6-10 Intermediate A – ages 8-12

Our **Musical Theater program** is for all students who seriously love to sing! The Camp welcomes your student whether he or she has sung in a chorus at school or just at home for fun! Musical theater campers will have fun rehearsing every day, while learning correct vocal technique, along with acting and movement. **Elementary** campers get to choose an elective such as Songwriting or Intro to Piano. **Intermediate A** campers get to pick electives including Pop Chorus, Jazz Vocal Ensemble, Songwriting, and more!



CLASSICAL MUSIC PROGRAM

Elementary – ages 6-10 (piano and strings) Intermediate A – ages 8-12 (piano, strings, and winds)

Our Classical Music program is for students who have been studying their instrument for at least one year. Campers get to rehearse together in two ensembles which perform in our final concert, plus they also get to choose electives. Elementary campers enjoy our now-famous Stomp class and can also try Songwriting, our new Suzuki String group class, and more. Intermediate A campers can try their hand in Our Latin Jazz Ensemble, Songwriting and Composition, or Suzuki Violin Group, to name just a few of what we offer!

JAZZ PROGRAM

Elementary – ages 6-10 (bass, drums, guitar, piano, and winds) Intermediate A – ages 8-12 (bass, drums, guitar, piano, and winds)

In our **Jazz Program**, campers get experience in playing together in a small group. They also get to express their creativity while learning how to improvise jazz! Everyone plays in at least two ensembles every day. **Elementary** campers also get to pick an elective such as Songwriting or Intro to Piano. **Intermediate A** campers can choose our Jazz Rock Guitar Ensemble, Rhythm Section Workshop, Songwriting, and more!

ROCK PROGRAM

Elementary – ages 6-10 (bass, drums, guitar, and piano) Intermediate A – ages 8-12 (bass, drums,

guitar, piano, and voice)

Campers enjoy playing the music they love – having fun and improving on their instrument at the same time. They rehearse twice a day and also get to try out new things in our elective classes. The Camp offers Intermediate and Advanced Programs in the areas of Classical Music, Jazz, Rock, Musical Theater and Contemporary Voice. We offer Honors Programs, which require an audition, in the areas of Classical Chamber Music, Instrumental and Vocal Jazz, and also Composition. In addition, serious students in the Pop Music realm, can enroll in our Institute of Contemporary Songwriting and our Brand - New Institute of Contemporary Vocal Performance.

BUS TRANSPORTATION

If you live in South Florida, we have a private bus company providing transportation from West Broward County, Miami Lakes, Aventura, Sunny Isles and Miami Beach. Other stops may be added upon request.

TUITION

Introduction to Music: \$500/2 week session. \$250/1 week session. Elementary Programs: \$\$650/2 week session. \$325/1 week session. Intermediate A Programs: \$700

The sessions are two-weeks, however a oneweek option is available for our Introduction to Music and Elementary Programs. The tuition includes a daily hot lunch. The Camp offers merit awards to students who have been selected to participate in the 2018 Superintendent's Honor Festival.

WHAT ELSE SHOULD I KNOW?

Camp hours for the Introduction to Music Program are 9:00 am -2:45 pm. Camp hours for the Elementary and Intermediate Programs are 9:00 am -3:45 pm. We offer extended care - morning and afternoon. We also have optional classes for the Intermediate A campers which take place after regular dismissal. The Camp concludes with our Final Concerts, where every camper gets to perform with their class in one of our beautiful concert halls.
