Now in its third year, if you are a songwriter and want to study with UM Frost School of Music faculty, then this is the program for you! Directed by UM professor, Dr. Raina Murnak, courses include Recording and Producing, Lyric Writing, The Art of Songwriting, Digital Presence and Branding and more! Enrollment is limited and an audition demo is required.

MUSICAL THEATER AND CLASSICAL CONTEMPORARY VOICE PROGRAM Intermediate B and Advanced Programs

Our **Voice Program** is a high-energy, demanding program where you will put together and perform a series of scenes from a Broadway musical all in a two-week session! In addition to the Musical Theater ensemble, campers have classes such as Jazz Vocal Ensemble, vintage Pop Vocal Ensemble, Vocal Technique, and more!

CLASSICAL MUSIC PROGRAM

Intermediate B and Advanced Programs: (piano, strings, and winds) **Honors Chamber Music Program:** (piano, winds, and strings)

In the Classical Music Program, instrumentalists can expect to be challenged in our performance ensembles! Classical musicians will also have the opportunity to learn about aspects of music that you may not have studied before, such as Intro to Improvisation for classical musicians, Songwriting and Composition. String players will be able to try our new classes in Contemporary String Styles and play in our new Contemporary String Ensemble.

JAZZ PROGRAM

Intermediate B and Advanced Programs: (bass, drums, guitar, piano, voice, and winds) **Honors Program:** Instrumental and Vocal Jazz

In our **Jazz Program**, campers will play in at two ensembles every day. Other courses include jazz theory, instrument workshops and a Jazz Seminar with guest artists. In every jazz class, the emphasis is placed on the art of jazz improvisation. Our goal is for you to leave our summer camp session as a much better jazz musician than when you started!

ROCK PROGRAM

Intermediate B and Advanced Programs: (bass, drums, guitar, piano, and voice)

The faculty in our **Rock Program** are all professional performers and recording artists who take their job as teachers very seriously. Not just a jam session (although we have that too), expect to be coached on different rock styles and how to perform them, to study instrumental technique, to learn about rock music theory and much more!

COMPOSITION PROGRAM Honors Composition Program

This Program is directed by UM Frost School of Music Professor Shawn Crouch. It has limited enrollment and samples of your compositions must be submitted in order to be accepted. This is a unique opportunity to be coached in a small group setting by an awardwinning composer and educator!

TEEN DORM PROGRAM

Our supervised teen dorm program is open to all campers (*ages 12 and up*). Campers can experience what it is like to live on a college campus. All meals, room, and weekend activities are included in our dorm program.
