#### □ INTERMEDIATE-B PROGRAM

# Tracks: Classical Instrumental, Piano (classical or jazz/pop), Jazz (all instruments including strings), Rock, and Voice/Musical Theater

- Entering grades 6 10 in the fall.
- Has been studying his/her instrument or voice for at least 2 full years.
- Music Proficiency level 2.5 4 and/or have completed either BOOK 2 or 3 of a standard music series in their instrument.

#### □ ADVANCED PROGRAM

Tracks: Classical Instrumental (for winds, strings, percussion, and classical guitar), Classical Piano, Jazz Instrumental (all instruments including strings), Rock, and Voice: Jazz, Musical Theater, and Classical

Students should be at an "Advanced" level of musical ability to participate. While this program is geared for high school students, exceptionally talented younger students who fulfill the requirements may also apply.

- Music Proficiency level 5.0 or above.
- Private students should be playing advanced repertoire, including technical studies.
- Advanced Rock Program applicants must have the ability to read music or chord charts.
- Jazz Program applicants must have experience in the skill of improvisation.
- Instrumentalists must have excellent sight-reading skills.
